Charles “Chuck” Liebling has been part of some of the most newsworthy real estate transactions in New Jersey, including Hackensack Meridian Health’s joint venture with Seton Hall on a new school of medicine; numerous expansions to the Rutgers University campus in New Brunswick; and working with the New Jersey Performing Arts Center (NJPAC) as it sponsors a mixed-use redevelopment on an adjacent property.

The partner at law firm Windels Marx Lane & Mittendorf LLP is usually at the forefront of many creative development projects in all areas of New Jersey. For example, he played a key role in moving forward the development of a cultural complex in downtown New Brunswick on behalf of New Brunswick Development Corp.

Liebling helped to obtain land use/zoning approvals on the former Morris Township/Morristown site of the Colgate-Palmolive Co. which, after more than 60 years, will make way for mixed-use redevelopment.

In Atlantic City, Liebling was a key member in the firm’s representation of Atlantic City Development Corp. on all facets of a major non-casino redevelopment project to provide new facilities for Stockton University and South Jersey Gas.
